

Change Benchmark Eligibility

Student eligibility for the Benchmark Module tests is determined by the student's enrolled grade. For example, a 3rd grade student would automatically be eligible for all grade 3 Benchmark Modules. High School students' Reading and Writing eligibility is based on enrolled grade; all grade 9-11 students will be eligible for all modules for Science and Math courses.

If a student is receiving instruction in a higher grade than the one they are enrolled in and should be eligible for Benchmark Module tests in that higher grade, LEA and School Administrators may adjust eligibility via the View/Edit Student screen in TIDE

To adjust a student's Benchmark Eligibility, select the drop-down menu for the appropriate subject (ELA, Math, or Science) and check the box to indicate that grade the student should be eligible for. Students may have different eligibilities in different subjects. Once the appropriate grades have been selected, click "save changes". The change will take effect immediately and students will be able to take the tests for the edited grades.
